## 48 Hour Band Challenge

returns to MOMFest in 2024 with local musicians, "Punk Rock" Tom Heffernan & Cara Lucille once again leading our organizational efforts. The Challenge has become a premier event for MOMFest, a great way to meet & learn from other musicians & create community. The challenge creates ad hoc groups from a pool of musicians that generally have not played together (& often don't know each other) to form bands that perform a short set of songs. Although the rules are different each year, they generally include the performance of 1 original & a pair of covers. In 2022, contestants were asked to write an original tune that used the phrase "fire hydrant." In 2023, contestants spun a wheel that determined how the group would modify a cover song, choices included: changing the lyrics to a hot dish recipe, flipping the genre or mood of the song, & performing the song in the style of a Minnesota artist (among others). We are currently planning the 48 Hr Band Challenge draft (where bands are chosen & rules presented) for Wednesday, July 17, 5:00 pm, at Patrick's on Third, (contestants must attend). The challenge is planned for Friday, July 19. In 2023 the event drew musicians of all performance levels from across the area (& state), from ages 18 to 66. These events are live-streamed and recorded for radio. Our 2023 event was hosted by Kaleb Braun-Schulz, live-streamed and recorded by Triple Falls Productions of Mankato. ## **Triple Falls Interactive Stage**


